COUNT 1: The defendant, on or about December 21, 2020, in Marion County, Oregon, did unlawfully and knowingly discharge mace or other deleterious agent, against Anthony Burke, a person said defendant knew to be a peace officer and while Anthony Burke was acting in the course of official duty.

COUNT 2: As part of the same act or transaction, as alleged in Count 1 above, the defendant, on or about December 21, 2020, in Marion County, Oregon, did unlawfully and knowingly discharge mace or other deleterious agent, against Logan R. Denney, a person said defendant knew to be a peace officer and while Logan R. Denney was acting in the course of official duty.

COUNT 3: As part of the same act or transaction, as alleged in Count 1, and Count 2 above, the defendant, on or about December 21, 2020, in Marion County, Oregon, did unlawfully and knowingly discharge mace or other deleterious agent, against Roger Hibbeler, a person said defendant knew to be a peace officer and while Roger Hibbeler was acting in the course of official duty.

COUNT 4: As part of the same act or transaction, as alleged in Count 1, Count 2, and Count 3 above, the defendant, on or about December 21, 2020, in Marion County, Oregon, did unlawfully and knowingly discharge mace or other deleterious agent, against Jeffrey M. Lucenti, a person said defendant knew to be a peace officer and while Jeffrey M. Lucenti was acting in the course of official duty.

COUNT 5: As part of the same act or transaction, as alleged in Count 1, Count 2, Count 3, and Count 4 above, the defendant, on or about December 21, 2020, in Marion County, Oregon, did unlawfully and knowingly discharge mace or other deleterious agent, against Vincennt Salazar, a person said defendant knew to be a peace officer and while Vincennt Salazar was acting in the course of official duty.

COUNT 6: As part of the same act or transaction, as alleged in Count 1, Count 2, Count 3, Count 4, and Count 5 above, the defendant, on or about December 21, 2020, in Marion County, Oregon, did unlawfully and knowingly discharge mace or other deleterious agent, against David B. Smith, a person said defendant knew to be a peace officer and while David B. Smith was acting in the course of official duty.

COUNT 7: As part of the same act or transaction, as alleged in Count 1, Count 2, Count 3, Count 4, Count 5, and Count 6 above, the defendant, on or about December 21, 2020, in Marion County, Oregon, did, unlawfully and intentionally, while in possession of a firearm, enter upon the premises located at 900 Court St. NE.

COUNT 8: As part of the same act or transaction, as alleged in Count 1, Count 2, Count 3, Count 4, Count 5, Count 6, and Count 7 above, the defendant, on or about December 21, 2020, in Marion County, Oregon, did unlawfully and knowingly enter and remain in a building located at 900 Court St. NE, with the intent to commit the crime of criminal mischief therein, and, while in said building, defendant was armed with a firearm, a deadly weapon. The state further alleges that, during the commission of the above-described offense, the defendant was armed with a deadly weapon.

COUNT 9: In an act constituting a scheme or plan common to Count 1, Count 2, Count 3, Count 4, Count 5, Count 6, Count 7, and Count 8, the defendant, on or about December 21, 2020, in Marion County, Oregon, did unlawfully and knowingly, while participating with 5 or more persons, engage in tumultuous and violent conduct, thereby recklessly creating a grave risk of causing public alarm.
