On July 30, 2021, the court held a hearing on Defendant's Motion to Compel. Michael Fuller appeared on behalf of Plaintiff; Caroline Turco appeared on behalf of Defendant. This post-hearing minute order is designed to briefly document what took place at that hearing.

Defendant's Request for Production (RFP) Number One

Consistent with the Multnomah County Judges' Consensus Agreement (August 2018), the parties agreed and the court will order that Plaintiff is to provide to Defendant screen shots of either phone contacts or social media contacts for all occurrence witnesses.

Defendant's RFP Number Eight

The court orders the request be narrowed as followed:

All documents relating to any interaction Plaintiff has had with a Portland Police Officer or other law enforcement officer during a protest, since May 31, 2020, including correspondence, video, photographs, and audio records.

Defendant's RFP Number Nine

The court orders the request will be narrowed as follows:

All documents relating to any protest or march in which Plaintiff was involved in 2020, including correspondence, video, audio records, photographs, and social media posts.

As to items **Eight and Nine**, the parties will confer after Plaintiff's counsel has had the opportunity to speak with his client to know what quantity of videos, photographs, and audio records are responsive to this order. If the quantity is voluminous to the extent that production is oppressive, Plaintiff will allow Defendant the opportunity to inspect the discovery.

Discovery items discussed at this hearing are to be provided by or before August 13, 2021.

Defendant is to draft an order consistent with this Minute Order and the discussions on the record to fully capture the court's rulings on Defendant's Motion to Compel and, after conferring with Plaintiff's Counsel as to its content, eFile the Proposed Order for signature.
